O2 Eligibility for Applicants



1) Nationality Requiremen

Applicants whose both parents and themselves hold foreign citizenship. (However, those who acquired foreign citizenship before starting an education equivalent to a Korean high school program are also eligible.)

2 Academic Requirement

Applicants who have completed the entire 12-year education curriculum equivalent to Korean elementary, middle, and high school education.

3 Language Proficiency Requirement

Korean Track	Applicants who meet one or more of the following conditions 1) Hold a TOPIK Level 2 or higher certificate 2) Have completed Level 4 or higher at a Korean language education center affiliated with a university in Korea 3) Have completed Level 2 or higher of the Korea Immigration and Integration Program (KIIP) or scored 41 points or higher on the preliminary test * Applicants admitted without obtaining TOPIK Level 3 or higher must complete at least 300 hours of Korean language courses within one year after admission as part of the first-year curriculum
English Track	Applicants who meet one or more of the following conditions 1) TOEFL score of 530 (PBT), 197 (CBT), or 71 (iBT) or higher 2) IELTS score of 5.5 or higher 3) CEFR Level B2 or TEPS score of 600 or higher ** Applicants who hold citizenship from a country where English is the native or official language are exempt from submitting an English proficiency test score, provided they submit proof of completing secondary or higher education in English (e.g., graduation certificate)
Chinese Track (Bilingual)	 Only applicants from countries where Chinese is an official language are eligible to apply For transfer admission: Applicants must have graduated (or be expected to graduate) from a three-year regular college (associate degree program) in Korea or abroad

- ※ English Track: Students enrolled in the English-taught program must complete at least 50% of the required credits for
 graduation in English. The university provides translation support systems, interpretation, and subtitle services to assist
 students during their studies.
- * Bilingual Program: Refers to an undergraduate program in which 50% or more of the required credits for graduation are conducted in a foreign language other than Korean (or with interpretation support). Korean language proficiency is not required.

Important Notes for Eligibility

- ① Foreign applicants who have completed all elementary and secondary education in a country with an education system of less than 12 years are recognized as having an academic background equivalent to that of a Korean high school graduate. (Based on Article 98, Paragraph 1, Item 9 of the Enforcement Decree of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of Korea)
- ② Applicants who have completed the final three years of an 11- or 12-year elementary and secondary education system in the same country are considered to have completed a high school curriculum. (This applies only to those who have completed at least 11 years of elementary and secondary education in two or more countries.)
- ③ GED certificates, qualification exams (domestic or foreign), homeschooling, online education, or adult education programs are not recognized as meeting the academic requirement.
- ④ Only foreign applicants whose both parents are non-Korean nationals and who have completed at least one year of study at a domestic or overseas university are eligible to apply for transfer admission. The number of transferable credits and subjects will be determined through Halla University's evaluation process.
- (§) Applicants who are deemed academically unqualified based on the qualification review or interview results will not be granted admission.
- ® The evaluation results and detailed contents of the admission process will not be disclosed under any circumstances.
- ① The interview language differs depending on the applicant's program of study: pplicants for the English-taught Program will be interviewed in English, and applicants for the Bilingual Program (Chinese) will be interviewed in Chinese.

• Important Notes for Admission Schedule

- ① Admission is possible after obtaining a D-2-2 (Undergraduate new or transfer) visa.
- ② Even if an applicant is accepted and registered, admission will be cancelled if the visa is denied or the applicant fails to enter Korea.
- 3 If any false information is found in the application or documents, the applicant will be fully responsible and admission will be revoked.
- ④ The applicant is responsible if the required documents do not arrive within the deadline.
- ⑤ The above schedule may change. In case of changes, notices will be posted on the English website (www.eng.halla.ac.kr) under "NOTICE." Individual notifications will not be provided.
- ® After paying the tuition, successful applicants must obtain the Certificate of Admission and apply for a D−2 (Student) visa.
- ① The visa issuance process usually takes about 3-4 weeks. Apply immediately after receiving the certificate.
- ® It is recommended to enter Korea by February 20, 2026 (Friday).
- (9) The entry schedule must be reported in advance to the Talent Development Office.
- [®] The new student orientation will be held in the fourth week of February 2026.

Notice on Submission of Apostille Certificate or Consular Confirmation for Academic Documents

1. What is an Apostille

An Apostille is a certification issued by the designated authority of a country that verifies the authenticity of a public or notarized document so that it is legally recognized in another member country (such as Korea).

2. Documents Requiring Apostille Certification

Certificate of Graduation, Academic Transcript, Other official academic documents

3. How to Obtain an Apostille

- ① Prepare Original Documents: Obtain the original documents from the issuing school or institution.
- ② Check the Issuing Authority: Confirm the designated authority that issues Apostilles in your country (e.g., Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Justice, etc.).
- 3 Apply and Pay the Fee: Submit the original document and application form, then pay the required fee.
- (4) Issuance Completed: The document will be issued with an Apostille stamp or certificate attached.
- * For Students from Apostille Member Countries Only
- * For Non-Member Countries: If your country is not a member of the Apostille Convention, you must obtain Consular Authentication either from the Korean Embassy in your country or from your country's Embassy in Korea.

O6 Important Notes for Applicants



1. Application and Personal Information

- ① Applicants must accurately fill in personal information including name, date of birth, contact details, admission type, and department. Any errors or omissions are the applicant's responsibility.
- ② After submission, changes or cancellations of application details are not permitted.

2. Restriction on Multiple Applications

- 1) Multiple applications within the same department are not allowed.
- ② Simultaneous enrollment in two or more universities under the special foreign student admission is prohibited.

3. Document Submission

- 1) All submitted documents will not be returned.
- ② Original documents must be submitted. If copies are submitted due to unavoidable circumstances, originals must be provided during the registration period after acceptance.
- 3 Documents not in Korean or English must be submitted with a notarized Korean or English translation.
- Graduating applicants must submit academic documents within the specified deadline, or admission may be canceled.

4. Language Proficiency

- ① Applicants who plan to submit language proficiency documents may be conditionally accepted.
- ② Failure to submit final language proficiency documents within the deadline will result in cancellation of acceptance.
- 3 Applicants admitted without TOPIK Level 3 must complete at least 300 hours of Korean language courses within one year.
- 4 Graduates in the Korean track must achieve TOPIK Level 4 or higher, or Level 4 in the Social Integration Program.

5. Interview and Identification

- ① Applicants must bring an ID (passport or alien registration card) on the interview day.
- 2 Remote applicants for online interviews must complete ID verification before and during the interview.

6. Acceptance and Registration

① Accepted students must pay tuition within the designated period; failure to do so will cancel admission.

7. Admission Cancellation

- 1) Admission may be cancelled in the following cases
 - If any submitted documents are found to be falsified, or if the applicant is ineligible or engaged in misconduct (e.g., proxy test)
 - · If the visa (student visa) is denied and the applicant cannot enter Korea
 - · If the immigration authorities reject or refuse the extension/change of visa status
